Volunteer Recognition 2019

The School Board will proclaim **April 2019** as **Volunteer Recognition Month**.

Our volunteers are doing a wonderful job to support Bloomington students!

- ♥ **164 Volunteers** from the community support learning and nurture relationships with students and staff in Bloomington Public Schools each week.
- ♥ **13 Reading Buddies** support **24** student readers weekly at Westwood Elementary.
- ♥ **39 Hope for Tomorrow** volunteers' mentor **39** students each month at Valley View and Oak Grove Middle Schools.
- ♥ **50 Homework Connection** volunteers assist **56** students in grades 3-5 with homework support at Indian Mounds, Westwood, and Normandale Hills Elementary Schools.
- ♥ **17 Homework Connection** volunteers at the Oxboro Library **Family Homework Connection** have provided **21** students from **10** schools, help to complete homework assignments, one or two evenings each week.
- ♥ **201 Normandale Community College** students have **245** placements as classroom assistants and America Reads/America Counts tutors.
- ♥ **35 Students** from **18** other colleges support learning in Bloomington classrooms.
- ♥ **10 Bloomington Faith Communities** support Bloomington Public Schools and programs.
