RESOLUTION FOR BOARD TO ADOPT:

RESOLVED, that the School Board of Independent School District 271 accepts grants totaling \$24,500 from the Bloomington Crime Prevention Association (BCPA) for school district violence prevention activities during the 2018-2019 calendar year.

RECOMMENDATION OF SUPERINTENDENT:

Approve.

DETAILED BACKGROUND:

Galaxy Youth Center - \$7,000 to support Sparks programming in purchasing supplies, equipment and paying instructors at all three Galaxy sites.

Kennedy High School - \$6,000 provides students the opportunity to participate in after school clubs, funds supervision in the open gym and open weight room, and provides transportation for students so they can get home safely after their activities.

Kids' SAFARI - \$1,000 to support a Lights on Afterschool celebration showcasing all of the different after school opportunities to students in Bloomington.

Jefferson High School - \$2,500 to offer an after school drop-in study program for students to receive additional support from teachers and tutors.

Learning Exchange - \$2,000 to provide a series of classes on the topics of "Information, Boundaries and Action" to create an environment for adults with developmental disabilities to become comfortable talking with a police officer, discussing personal physical boundaries, and assessing who to contact if they are in danger or distress.

Metro South ABE - \$2,000 provides funds to offer a financial literacy workshop to students which will cover the basics of budgeting and saving while also informing them of financial safety and how to protect themselves from fraud.

Youth Enrichment - \$3,000 offering Act Up! Stop Bullying drama class to students.

Kennedy and Jefferson High School - \$500 to each high school for their graduation night celebration.

Total dollars awarded this funding period by BCPA, generated from Book'Em to school district violence prevention activities is \$24,500.
