**RESOLUTION FOR BOARD TO ADOPT:**

RESOLVED, that the School Board of Independent School District 271 approves the 2017-2020 Achievement and Integration Plan and its budget for the 2017–2018 school year in the amount of \$2,007,539.41. In the event of a decrease or increase in funding from the Minnesota Department of Education, the contents of the plan and corresponding budget will be adjusted accordingly.

**DETAILED BACKGROUND:**

In accordance with Minnesota Statute 124D. Sections 861-862, Minnesota's Achievement and Integration program was established to help close Minnesota's academic achievement gap and increase integration opportunities for protected class students. Minnesota law passed requires all school districts receiving Achievement and Integration funding to submit a new three-year plan to the Minnesota Department of Education (MDE). The new Achievement and Integration plan must be aligned with the World's Best Workforce plan. Our deadline for submission to the MDE is March 15, 2017.

We have received input on our plan from key district stakeholder groups and have vetted our plan with leadership at the MDE.
