**RESOLUTION FOR BOARD TO ADOPT:**

RESOLVED, that the School Board of Independent School District 271 approves the Collaborative Agreement between the following parties: Independent School District 271, Independent School District 272, Independent School District 280, Hennepin County, through its Human Services and Public Health Department; Bloomington Public Health, the Public Health Division of the City of Bloomington, and Community Action Partnership of Suburban Hennepin to become mandatory members of Hennepin South Services Collaborative ("HSSC"). This Collaborative Agreement shall be in effect as of the date signed and shall continue in effect for five years (2018-2023).

The School Board authorizes the Superintendent to sign the attached Collaborative Agreement. HSSC members shall review the Collaborative Agreement annually.

**DETAILED BACKGROUND:**

HSSC was first established in 1993 pursuant to a Joint Powers Agreement for the purpose of engaging in joint planning and collaboration of social and mental health services for children and their families. This renewal agreement is for five years (2018-2023) and reflects the current agreement of the parties committed to providing and improving a comprehensive, collaborative, and culturally appropriate integrated service delivery system to children residing in the Bloomington, Eden Prairie and Richfield school districts.

The District's legal counsel and insurance agent of record have reviewed the Collaborative Agreement.
