RESOLUTION FOR BOARD TO ADOPT:

RESOLVED, that the School Board of Independent School District 271 accepts the amendment to the McKinney Vento Homeless Children and Youth Education Grant from the Minnesota Department of Education and authorizes Administration to enter into the grant amendment for the 2019-2020 school year.

BACKGROUND:

Learning Supports was awarded a portion of a grant from the Minnesota Department of Education. The grant supports addressing the challenging education needs of students who are homeless and to facilitate the enrollment, attendance, and success in school of homeless children and youth. This is the second year of a two-year grant effective September 2018 through June 2020 totaling \$80,000 that includes Richfield, Wayzata and Bloomington school districts. Robbinsdale school district was but no longer is part of the grant. The remaining three school districts of Bloomington, Richfield and Wayzata will share evenly the \$40,000 allocated for this school year.
