Mr. Wolak,

So that Bloomington will not be charged for these services going forward, I was instructed by Georgia Kedrowski, Chief Customer Experience Officer, last month to prepare a letter of formal discontinuation of services. Accordingly, this is written notification that our school district, Bloomington Public Schools, will be discontinuing the use of the following TIES services.

TIES Student Information System (TSIS) - we are discontinuing use and will no longer require application access after June 30, 2016, including TIES SchoolView. Historical TSIS data will continue to be available through a TIES Data System license agreement.

TIES Data System - data storage for TSIS, Tests & Assessments, Cognos, iCue with ODBC support. We are requesting two (2) additional quarters of access, from July 1, 2016 through December 31, 2016 at a rate of \$5/student/year. We acknowledge that on January 1, 2017, our Student Information System data will be permanently deleted from TIES hosting servers.


TIES EnrollView System - we are discontinuing use and will no longer require application access to this system after July 6, 2016. We acknowledge that on October 1, 2016, our EnrollView system data will be permanently deleted from TIES hosting servers.

TIES iContent - we are discontinuing use and will no longer require application access to this system after June 30, 2017.

TIES Finance/HR/Payroll System - we are discontinuing use and will no longer require application access to this system after **December 31, 2016**. We are requesting two (2) additional quarters of ODBC/View Only access, from January 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017 at a rate of \$10/student/year. We acknowledge that on July 1, 2017, our Finance/HR/Payroll system data will be permanently deleted from TIES hosting servers.

We acknowledge that support for systems after end dates will be billed at an hourly rate of \$150.00 per hour.
