BACKGROUND:

The purpose of Policy 510.2 is to ensure no use of alcohol by attendees at school or district-sponsored events, such as student banquets or celebrations outside school.

On January 15, 2019, the School Board Policy Committee reviewed draft revisions to Policy 510.2 prepared and presented by Administration. The committee discussed the draft revisions and made additional agreed upon edits. The revised policy is being recommended for approval.

The policy is not a mandatory according to the Minnesota School Boards Association (MSBA).

The District's legal counsel has reviewed the Policy.

POLICY 510.2 SCHOOL OR DISTRICT-SPONSORED EVENTS

I. PURPOSE

To ensure no use of alcohol by attendees at school or district-sponsored events, such as student banquets or celebrations outside school.

II. GENERAL STATEMENT OF POLICY

At school or district-sponsored events, such as student banquets or celebrations outside school there should be no alcohol use by attendees. Event organizers and attendees will be informed of start and end times for the event and that they must refrain from using alcohol at these events.

The respective school administrator or district administrator is responsible for dissemination of this Policy to event organizers.
