Grades: 10, 11 & 12.

1550 hours required for MN cosmetology license

Trimester 1, 2 & 3

CT3001 Cosmetology Introduction.

No prerequisites. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 90 Hours towards licensure.

Includes an introduction to Cosmetology concepts and skills. Course is designed to help students explore a career in Cosmetology. Emphasis on hair care, styling/braiding, special occasion hairstyles, manicuring, basic facials, nail art, infection control, communication skills, basic electricity, anatomy & physiology, professional image, MN state laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands-on workshops include: shampooing, conditioning treatments, braiding, hair styling techniques, manicures, and basic facials.

Trimester 1, 2 & 3

CT3002 Cosmetology Concepts 1. Prerequisite: Intro. to Cosmetology. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 90 Hours towards licensure.

Emphasis is on haircutting, artificial nail enhancements, facial waxing, infection control, life skills, diseases and disorders, nail structure and growth, MN State laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands on workshops will include: haircutting, hairstyling, artificial nail enhancements, facials and facial waxing.

Trimester 1, 2 & 3

CT3003 Cosmetology Concepts 2. Prerequisite: Cosmetology Concepts 1. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 90 Hours towards licensure.

Emphasis is on hair color, foiling, artificial nail enhancements, advanced makeup, advanced facials, brow tinting, skin disorders and diseases, skin structure, growth, and nutrition, infection control, communication, anatomy and physiology, MN State laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands-on workshops include: hair coloring, foiling, facials, waxing, all nail services, makeup, and brow tinting.

Trimester 1, 2 & 3

CT3026 Cosmetology Concepts 3. Prerequisite: Cosmetology Concepts 2. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 90 Hours towards licensure.

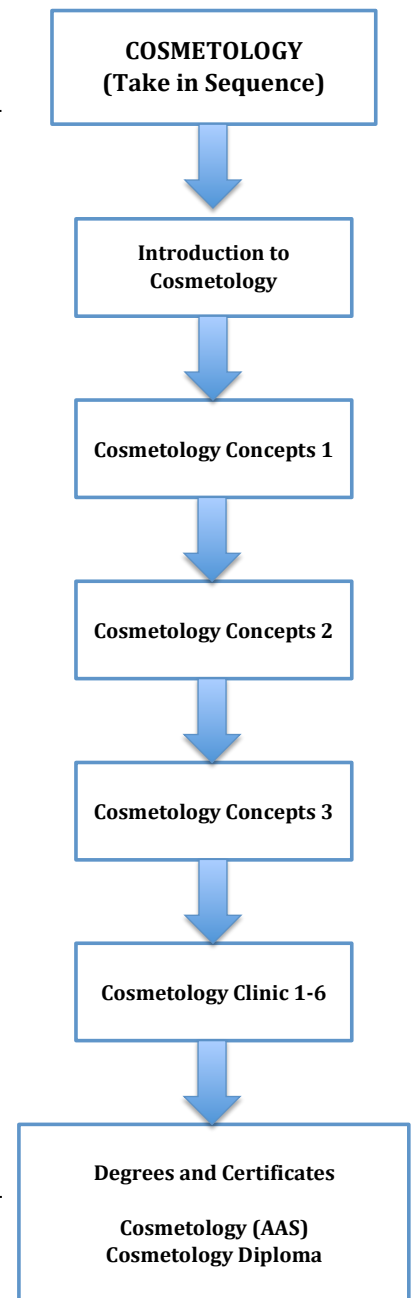
Emphasis is on corrective hair color, lightning of hair, perming, all nail services, advanced makeup and facials, disorders and diseases, skin and nail structure, growth and nutrition, infection control, communication, anatomy and physiology, MN state laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands on workshops will include: corrective hair color, perming, all nail, skin and hair services.

Trimester 1, 2 & 3

CT3027, CT3032-CT3036 Cosmetology Clinic 1-6

Prerequisite: Cosmetology Concepts 3. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 90 Hours towards licensure.

Emphasis is on transitioning to the clinic floor services and working on clients, chemistry, communication skills, MN state laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands on clinic will include: all hair, skin and nail services.



Nail Technology

Trimester 1

CT3041 Nail Technology Intro

No prerequisites. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 90 Hours towards licensure.

This course is designed to help advance students toward their career in Nail Technology. The emphasis is on manicuring, pedicuring, artificial nail enhancements, infection control, life skills, nail diseases and disorders, nail structure and growth, MN State laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands-on workshops will include: manicuring, pedicuring and artificial nail enhancements.

Trimester 2

CT3042 Nail Technology Concepts 1

Prerequisite: Nail Tech Intro. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits, 90 Hours towards license.

This course is designed to help advance students toward their career in Nail Technology. The emphasis is on advanced manicuring, advanced pedicuring, artificial nail enhancements including acrylic and gel, chemistry, MN State laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands-on workshops will include: manicuring, pedicuring and artificial nail enhancements.

Trimester 3

CT3043 Nail Technology Concepts 2

Prerequisite: Nail Tech Intro. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits, 90 Hours towards license.

This course is designed to help advance students towards their career in Nail Technology. The emphasis is on artificial nail enhancements including acrylic and gel, nail art, MN State laws, rules, safety, and sanitation. Hands-on clinic will include: manicuring, pedicuring, and artificial nail enhancements.

Year 2 – Trimester 1, 2 or 3

CT3044 Nail Technology Clinic 1

Prerequisite: Nail Tech Intro. Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits, 90 Hours towards license.

Emphasis is on transitioning to the clinic floor services and working on clients, chemistry, communication skills, MN state laws and rules, safety and sanitation. Hands on clinic will include: all nail services.

****Students will be able to apply all their 350 hours towards the MN Nail Technology License and prep for the State Board Exam. Upon High School Graduation or G.E.D. and passing the State Board Exams; the student should be able to obtain a full MN Nail Technology License.****
