Trimester 2

CT3030 HUC 1. No prerequisites.

Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 6 HTC Credits

Bundle Includes:

HUC Fundamentals: This course is an introduction to Health Unit Coordinator nursing unit procedures, routines, and communication devices. The student will learn the importance of using critical thinking, problem solving and effective communication skills in the healthcare environment. An introduction to the roles of the health care team members, admission, discharge and transfer procedures will be covered.

Medical Terminology: Students will also be acquainted with medical terms and abbreviations used in healthcare settings.

Trimester 3

CT3031 HUC 2. Prerequisite: HUC 1

Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 5 HTC Credits.

Bundle Includes:

Processing Physicians Orders: This course is designed to give the student the skills needed in transcribing physician's orders. Opportunities will be provided for the student to gain experiences transcribing medication orders, diagnostic studies orders, treatment orders, diet orders and activity orders. The student will become acquainted with specialty orders such as admission orders, preoperative orders and postoperative orders. Computer transcription will also be introduced.

Diagnostic and Therapeutic Procedures: Designed to acquaint the student with diagnostic tests, procedures, medication types and terminology, therapies, and nursing procedures.

After Graduation

To be eligible to receive HUC certification, 2 additional classes must be taken at HTC: Computer Essentials in a Digital World (3 credits) and Health Unit Coordinator Internship (3 credits)

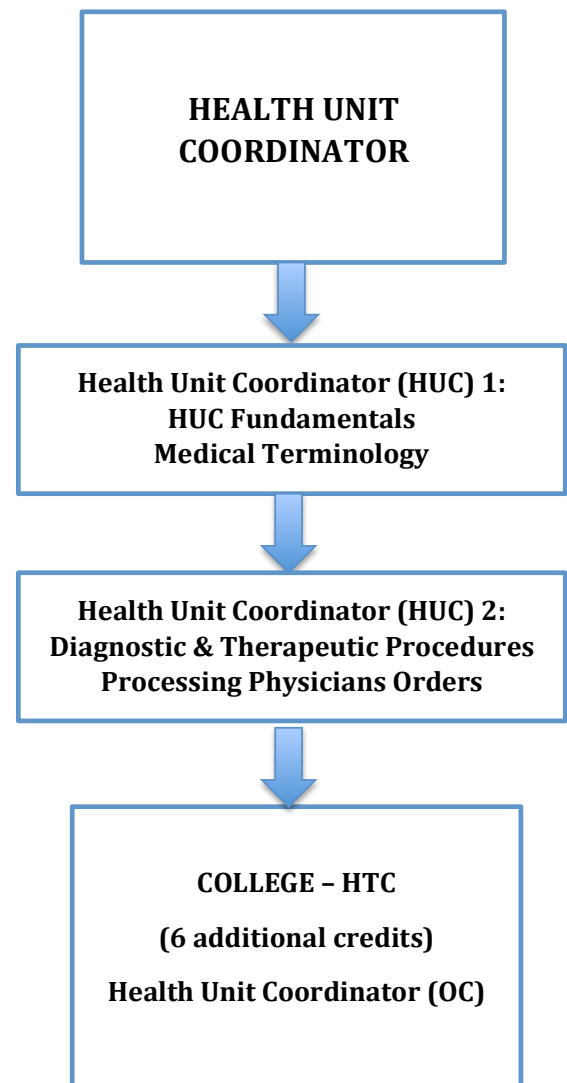

EMERGENCY MEDICAL RESPONDER (EMR)

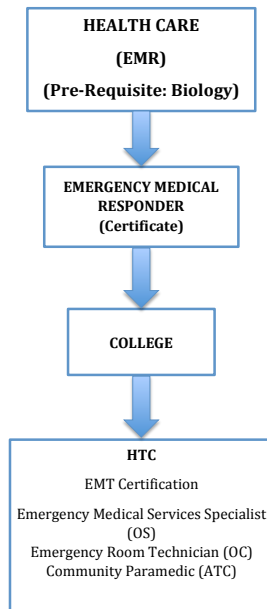

Trimester 3

CT3004 Emergency Medical Responder (EMR). Prerequisite: Biology

Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 3 HTC Credits

This course is designed to provide the First Responder at the scene of a medical or trauma emergency with the necessary knowledge and skills to manage patient care until the arrival of ambulance personnel. This course meets the MN EMSRB requirements. Course is intended for any individual charged with "first response" duties. This is a one Trimester course which includes a one Saturday skills test at HTC.

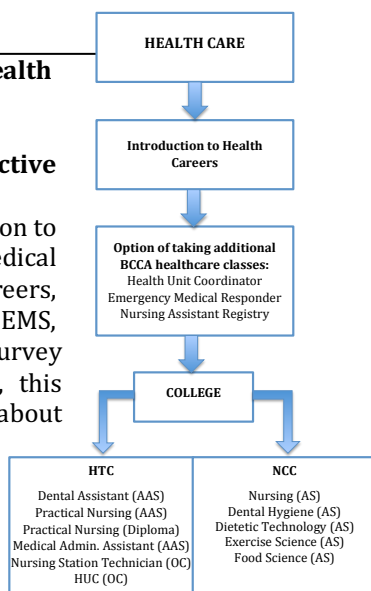
Trimester 1

CT3008 Introduction to Health Careers

No prerequisites

Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 3 HTC Credits

An exploration and orientation to healthcare fields, e.g. medical assisting, medical office careers, nursing, pharmacy tech., EMS, and HUC. Intended to be a survey of the healthcare industry, this course teaches students about various careers in healthcare, the job outlook, career pathways, and what is needed to be successful in healthcare.

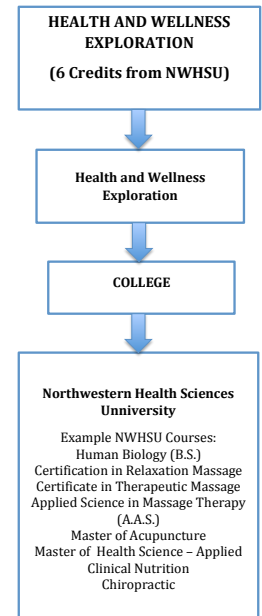

Trimester 2

CT3007 Health and Wellness Exploration.

Earn 2 HS STEM/elective credits and 6 NWHSU Credits. Fulfills 10th Grade Health Requirement

Survey course that introduces students to health, wellness, and medicine as consumers and practitioners. This course covers health promotion and behaviors, disease prevention, access to health, wellness, and medical services, and health professions. Students will learn from visiting health care practitioners and case studies about the different healthcare fields and what students need to do to work in that field.

Value of 1 HTC Credit: \$157

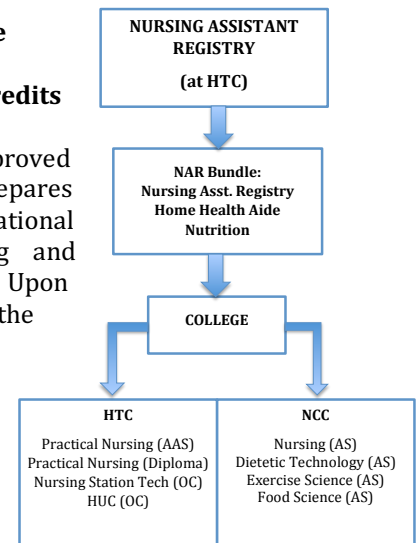
Trimester 1

CT3014 Nursing Assistant Registry /Home Health Aide

No prerequisites.

Earn 3 HS STEM/elective credits and 6 HTC Credits

This certificate course is approved by the MN DOH and prepares students to take the National Nursing Assistant Training and Competency Evaluation Test. Upon successful completion of the test, students are placed on the Nursing Assistant Registry (NA/R). The NA provides care under the supervision of licensed nurses. Course also includes Home Health Aide.
