Reviewing a student's portfolio.

As a part of the **Personal Growth Plan (PGP)** process, students at each grade are **assigned activities** that help them set relevant and achievable goals, take action to achieve their goals and make informed choices for high school and beyond.

about me

The **"about me"** tab is the best place to review a student's portfolio and progress on their personal growth plan.

The tab is broken down into four sections:

my PGP section:

- Click on **"goals"** to see a student's current goals, click on a specific goal to see "action plans" for the goal.
- Click on **"tasks"** to see a student's progress on their PGP activities. By clicking on a specific task, you can review the content of the PGP activity.

my assessments section:

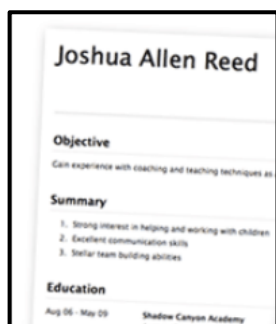
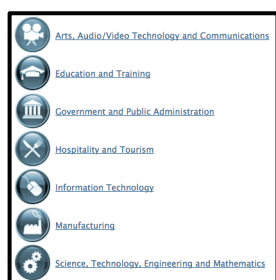
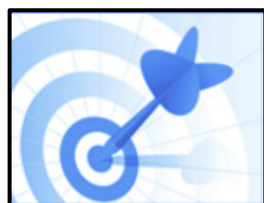
- Each year students in grades 8-11 complete a different career based assessment via a PGP activity **that helps them to identify potential careers of interest**. The assessments recommend potential careers that might be a good fit for the student based on their personality, interests and strengths.
- Upon completion of each assessment, **it is recommended that students spend additional time reviewing the results and researching potential careers**. Careers of interest should be added to **"my careers of interest"**. Career research tools are available on the **"careers"** tab.

interesting things about me section

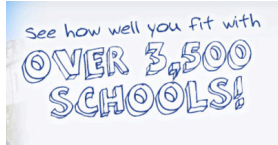
- Reviewing a student's **"portfolio"** is the fastest way to see a student's progress. It is broken down into five sections.
- The student **"resume"** allows students to keep a record of activities, volunteer time, awards and achievements. Once entered, a resume can be formatted for printing.
- The **"game plan"** allows a student to enter their general goal for after they graduate from high school. This can be modified as the student's plans change.

The “colleges” tab is the go to for **everything college!**

The tab is broken down into three sections:

my colleges section:

- As students research and begin applying to colleges they can enter **colleges of interest, colleges they are applying to, request transcripts and letters of recommendation.**
- Upcoming college visits** to the schools College & Career Center are listed so students can sign up to speak with an admission representative in person.

college research section:

- The “**SuperMatch™**” college search tool helps students to find potential colleges based on a variety of colleges and compare multiple colleges side by side.
- The “**college lookup**” provides an overview of most colleges and a direct link to the colleges website as well as statistics about acceptance from previous students who applied from their school.
- Direct links to ACT prep resources, FAFSA information and other “**college resources**” are just a click away on this option.
- Newly available, “**scattergrams**” allow students to view the average ACT and GPA for students from their school who were accepted from prior years.
- Enrichment opportunities at colleges and in the community can be found by clicking on “**enrichment programs**”. Summer is a great opportunity to explore and expand your learning.

scholarships & money section:

- Great resource for finding local and national scholarships. The “**scholarship list**” includes many Bloomington based scholarships frequently awarded to students at your school.

- The career assessments in this section recommend potential careers that might be a good fit for a student based on their personality, interests and strengths.
