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Pathways to GRADUATION

PATHWAYS TO GRADUATION is a comprehensive framework that identifies key milestones students need to meet in order to be prepared for the next level of study, graduate on time, and enter college or a career with the necessary skills to be successful.



MILESTONES define behaviors, achievement levels, or experiences a child needs to accomplish at certain stages along the continuum in order to be prepared to graduate.

- Milestones are a minimal level that students are encouraged to attain.
- All students are encouraged to exceed the Milestones and strive to the highest possible level.



INDICATORS identify data collected to monitor the district's progress toward preparing students to graduate, and to achieve the desired readiness throughout their school career.

PATHWAYS TO GRADUATION provides a learning path from birth to graduation by aligning the core educational departments - Academic Services, Students Services and Community Services - and linking schools, departments, programs and strategies into a single, cohesive framework. To meet the individual needs and interests of students and families, multiple learning options exist for students. Regardless of the need or motivation, more than one academic "pathway" is available to students.

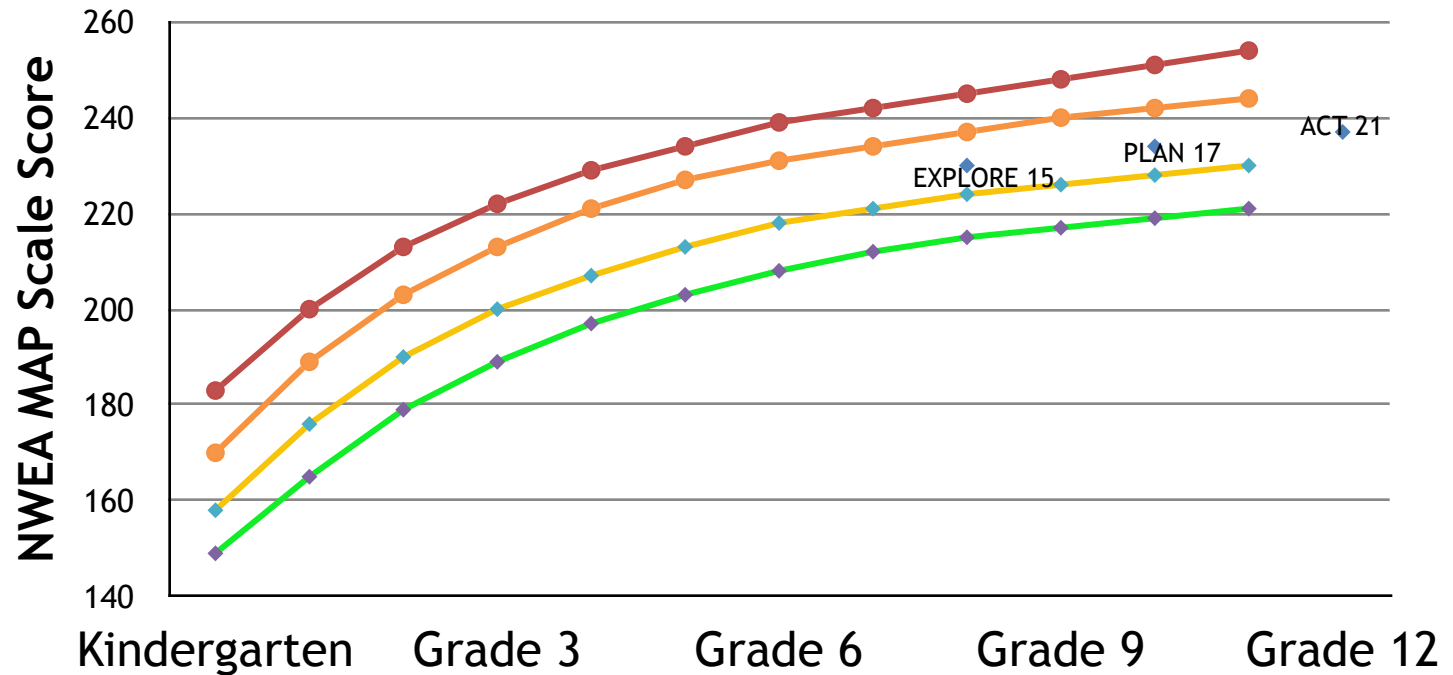

INITIATIVE FOR LASTING CHANGE is a collaborative effort between the District and community partners to ensure that all students learn to read proficiently by the end of 3rd Grade.

K-12 Pathways to Graduation; NWEA MAP Spring Reading Scale Scores linked to ACT Reading Scale Scores

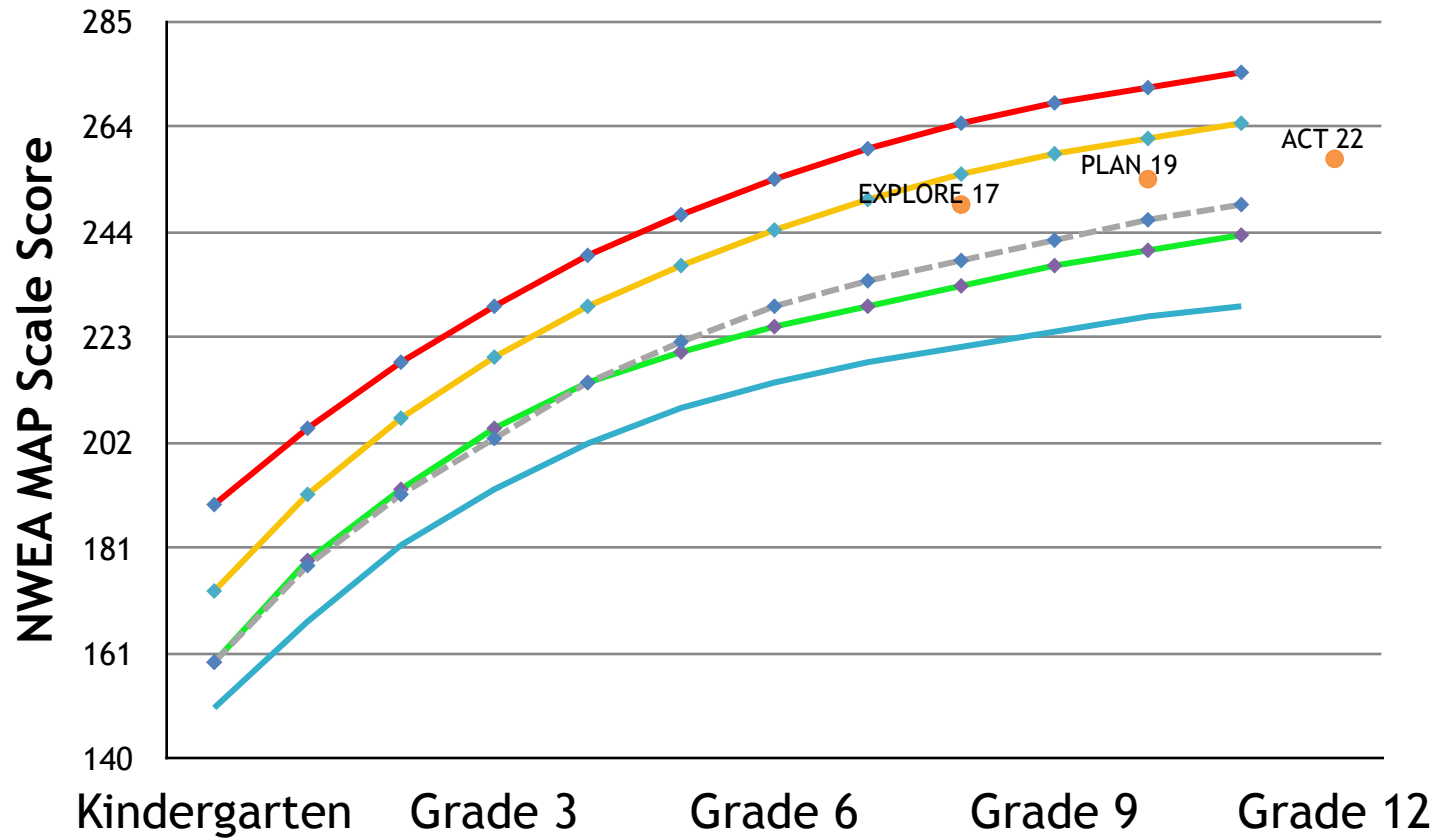


EXPLORE, PLAN and ACT

Reading and Math Benchmarks

- The ACT College Readiness Benchmarks were established from a large study of over 10,000 High Schools and over 400,000 students.
- The validity of the EXPLORE, PLAN and ACT College Readiness Benchmarks was investigated with a study of 76,000 students and over 90 colleges.
- The Benchmarks represent the ACT score that predicts with 75% accuracy that the student (who received this score in High School) will get a freshman English grade of “C” or better and with 50% accuracy that the student will get a grade of “B” or better in freshman English.

K-12 Pathways to Graduation; NWEA MAP Math Spring Scale Scores linked to ACT Math Scale Scores

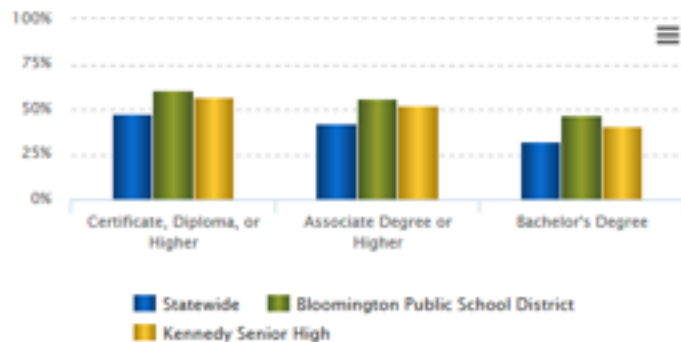

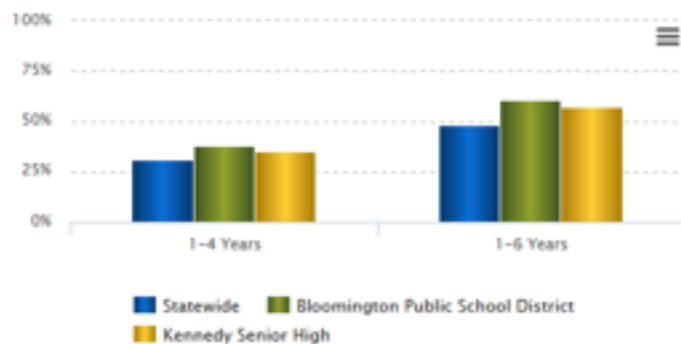

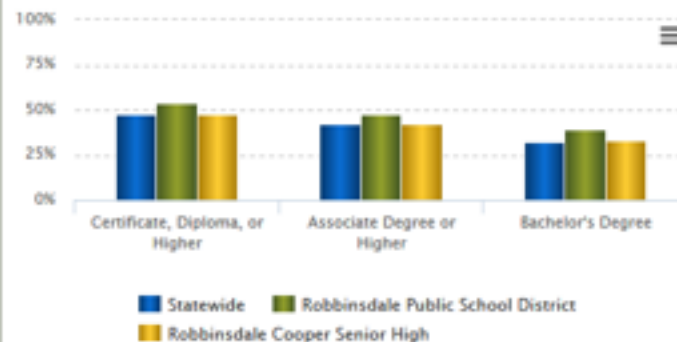

Percent of High School Graduates Completing a Degree or Certificate within:



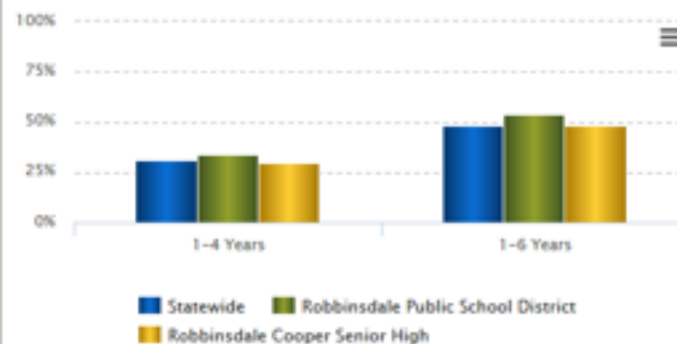

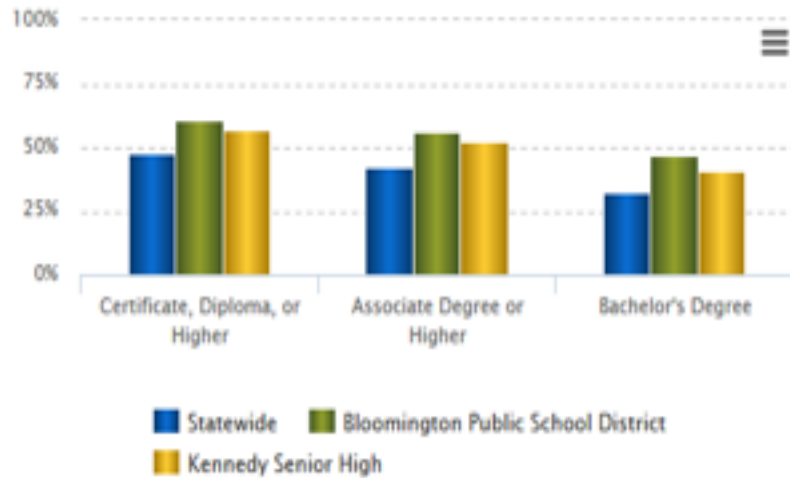
Time to College Completion

Percent of High School Graduates Completing a Degree or Certificate within:



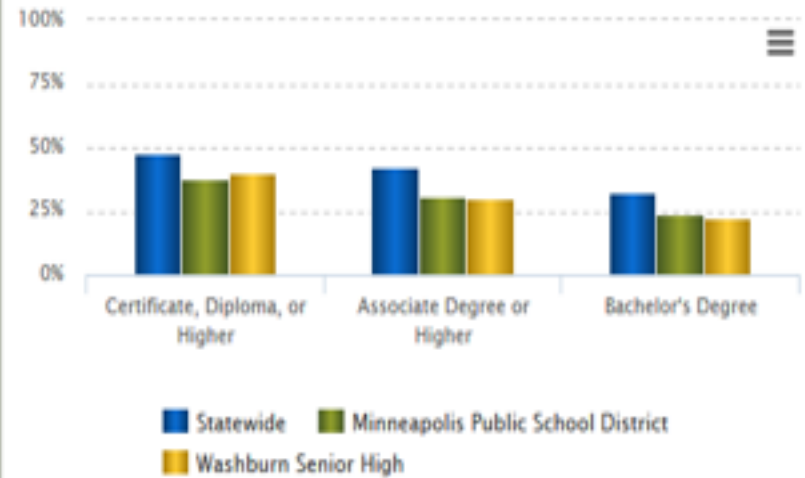

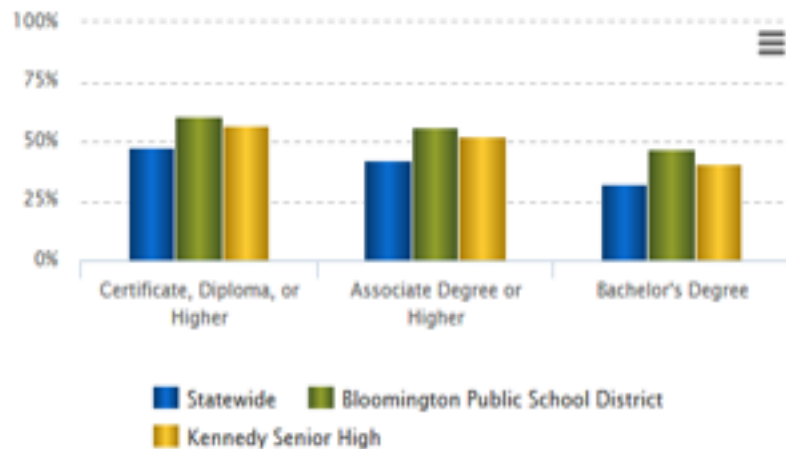

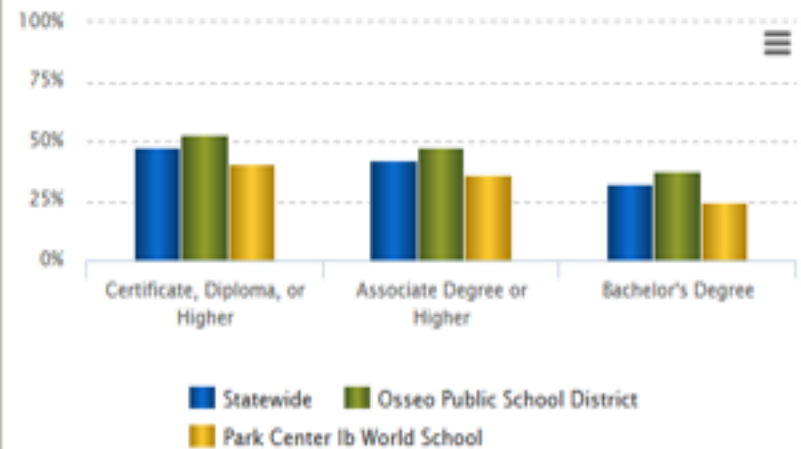

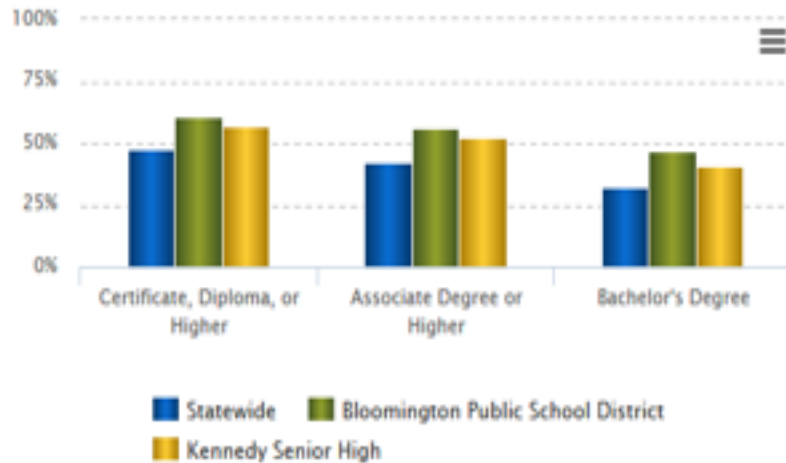

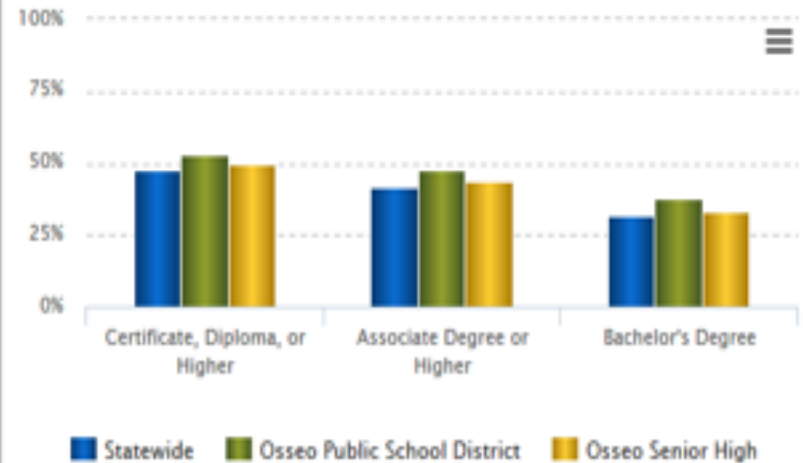
